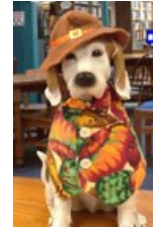

New this Fall:

New Spanish Language Collection - Our character books have moved and, in their place, we have created collections of early learning concept book just perfect for little fingers to browse.



Our newest bin is a collection of Spanish picture books.

There are favorites like *Elefante y Cerdita* (*Elephant & Piggie*) and *Jorge El Curioso* (*Curious George*) along with traditional stories in both English and Spanish. These are great to read-aloud or to use when learning to read in Spanish. Vienen a la biblioteca y lean uno hoy.

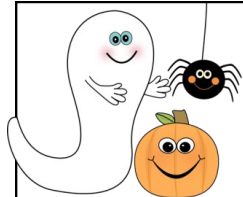

Tuesday, October 31

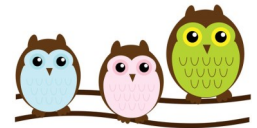
Story-time: 10:30 am / Parade: 11 am
